One-half of St. Clair Catholic DSB's allotment was used by Superintendents of Education Deb Crawford and Scott Johnson (21C board leads) to attend the international New Pedagogies for Deep Learning conference in Seattle, WA in Oct/2015. The SCCDSB is currently using CODE/TLF money to support participation in this worldwide collaborative inquiry under the leadership of Michael Fullan. The conference provided SCCDSB the opportunity to connect with Michael Fullan and other senior administration teams from around the world who are at various stages of implementation.

The funds cover the following costs for both Deb Crawford and Scott Johnson:

1. Registration costs
2. Transportation costs
3. Accommodation costs (hotel/meals)

The remainder of our board's allotment will be spent as follows: Four members of the Corporate Services team will be attending an on-site visit to the head office of Baragar Systems in Surrey, BC. The Baragar Systems planning software provides the functionality to make data-driven decisions with regards to capital planning, operating budget projections, classroom configurations and staffing decisions. Through consultation with Baragar, SCCDSB staff plan to achieve optimal use of the system and as a result will spend more time discussing options and solutions, rather than time gathering the data to identify the issues.
