Our newly developed Strategic Plan has identified "innovation that promotes student confidence and success" as a strategic priority. There is an appetite within the broader leadership of the Board (Trustees, Superintendents and Senior Staff, Principals, Community) to pursue the possibility of a differentiated approach to learning in an environment that embodies that differentiated approach.
