

Director of Education

The Kawartha Pine Ridge District School Board (KPR) is seeking a dynamic and collaborative leader as its new Director of Education. The successful candidate will assume the role ideally on or before February 1, 2021.

KPR supports a world-class education for approximately 33,000 students in 91 schools spread across its diverse jurisdiction spanning over 7,000 square kilometers in rural and small urban communities in southeastern Ontario, including the Kawarthas to the north, and south to Lake Ontario; and from Hastings County in the east, on the edge of the City of Oshawa along Lake Ontario. KPR's central board operations are located in the City of Peterborough. The region is home to several excellent post-secondary institutions, including Trent University, Fleming College, Durham College, Loyalist College and Ontario Tech University (UOIT).
